The Arthur Shearing Shed
Built in the early 1900's by the Piesse family who had extensive pastoral holdings in the area. Later as the area became more closely settled, other farmers brought their sheep here for shearing, some driving the sheep a considerable distance.

Kylie Dam Reserve is a 220 hectare property which includes a dam, pipeline and water tank that are over 90 years old. The Shire in partnership with the community and Natural Trust are rehabilitating the site for the future.

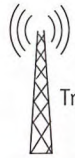
Heart of the Great Southern

Wagin's Big Ram and Water Gardens

Located on the Arthur River road on the western approach to Wagin, this delightful park with ponds and walk trails is ideal for picnics and BBQs. Off street parking, children's playground, toilets, gazebos and electric BBQs are available.

Cascades Road to Esperance → Good gravel all weather road abundant with wildflowers

Newdegate - Gateway to the Holland Track:
Lake Bidy - former 1922 townsite with old hall, shop, sports ground and Anglican Church.
Dragon Rock - lies on the 1893 Holland Track used by gold miners to travel to Kalgoorlie & Coolgardie. Wheel ruts are still visible on the western edge.
Dickman Rock - the original water catchment for Newdegate. Magnificent views over the surrounding countryside.
Namma Rock - massive granite monolith with numerous 'namma' water holes used by aborigines. Unique flora and fauna. Rarely visited.
Lake Bryde - water skiing and canoeing when full. Bush camping.

Lake King & Varley:
Lake King Heritage Trails - four graded walktrails of varying length with an interpretive brochure available.
Roe Heritage Trail - a drive and walk trail located 23km south of Lake King on the Newdegate Ravensthorpe Road. Includes Lake Pallarup and Mt Madden.
Wildflowers superb displays along most road verges in Spring.
Varley Museum - exhibits from 1920s. Contact Varley Store on 9875 1200.
Granite Monoliths & Nature Reserves are scattered throughout the region. All are unique in their own way and are worth visiting.
